## Modern Design and Technology

PRESS RELEASE

The 2024 Forte arrives with mindful updates, including re-packaged Advanced Driver Assistance Systems (ADAS). The GT-Line trim level now comes standard with Front Collision Alert (FCA) Fusion, a combination of Front Collision Alert-Cyclist (FCA-Cyc), Electronic Parking Brake (EPB), Highway Driver Assist (HDA) and Navigation Based Smart Cruise Control (NSCC). The GT-Line Tech Package is no longer available. A long-standing compact sedan within Kia's vehicle lineup, the Forte continues to be offered in four trim levels: the LX, LXS, GT-Line and GT.

### EXTERIOR

The exterior of the Forte incorporates a modern design identity including:

- Sleek, expressive headlight designs
- Tiger-nose grille
- Front and rear bumpers that accentuate a wide, strong image
- LED fog lights seamlessly integrated into air-intake grille (GT, GT-Line only)
- 16-inch and 17-inch dark metal gray alloy wheel designs (LXS, GT-Line only)
- Sporty LED taillight/rear combination lamp design (GT, GT-Line only)
- Trunk lid spoiler that emphasizes rear width and stability

### INTERIOR

Within, the Forte delivers a modern cabin defined by a driver-centric, high-tech interior space. Key features include:

- A large 4.2-inch color TFT LCD cluster (standard on all trims)
- Wireless Apple CarPlay and Android Auto is standard through the 8-inch touchscreen display audio/infotainment system
- 10.25-inch wide touchscreen navigation/infotain-

ment standard on GT and GT-Line, includes free MapCare updates

- Center console with available integrated Electronic Parking Brake (EPB) and Auto Hold
- Available rear USB charger
- Smart Key now features remote start (standard on GT, GT-Line)
- Available SynTex synthetic leather seating

In addition, the Forte continues to deliver a com-

fortable and spacious five-seat cabin with up to 111.3 cu.-ft. of passenger and cargo volume.

### POWER

The Forte offers two proven engines, allowing customers to choose between an enjoyable driving experience that is either smooth and efficient or deliberately sporty and responsive.

The 2.0-liter MPI I-4 engine is coupled to an Intelligent Continuously

Variable Transmission (IVT)

It makes 147 horsepower and 132 lb.-ft. torque. In the FE trim, it achieves 41 MPG on the highway.

The turbocharged 1.6-liter GDI I-4 engine (GT) is available with a 7-speed dual clutch transmission (DCT) or 6-speed manual transmission.

The turbo engine makes 201 horsepower and 195 lb.-ft. torque.

### DRIVER ASSISTANCE

The Forte's driver assistance systems include:

- Standard Lane Following Assist (LFA): Follows lane markings that the system detects and provides steering inputs to help maintain the vehicle in the center of the lane

- Available Highway Driving Assist (HDA): Uses federal highway speed limit information from the navigation system and, under certain conditions, will automatically adjust speed to be within the posted speed limit

- Available Navigation Based Smart Cruise Control-Curve (NSCC-C): Leverages the navigation system to lower the vehicle's speed proactively before upcoming curves
