**Prov. 31:27** She looks well to the ways of her household  
and does not eat the bread of idleness.

**The Wise Worker Works Hard**

**Prov. 31:13** She seeks wool and flax,  
and works with willing hands.

**Prov. 31:15** She rises while it is yet night  
and provides food for her household  
and portions for her maidens.

**The Wise Worker is a Good Steward**

**Prov. 31:14** She is like the ships of the merchant;  
she brings her food from afar.

**Prov. 31:16** She considers a field and buys it;  
with the fruit of her hands she plants a vineyard.

**The Wise Worker is Profitable**

**Prov. 31:18** She perceives that her merchandise is profitable.  
Her lamp does not go out at night.

**The Wise Worker Gives Generously**

**Prov. 31:20** She opens her hand to the poor  
and reaches out her hands to the needy.

**The Wise Worker is Secure in Jesus Christ**

**Prov. 31:25** Strength and dignity are her clothing,  
and she laughs at the time to come.
