New Life from and in Jesus—Matthew 9:18-19, 25-26; 27: 50-53; Luke 7:11-16; John 1:1-4; 17:1-3; 10:27-28; 1 Corinthians 15:12-58; Romans 6:1-14; Ephesians 4:17-25; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; Revelation 21:5-7; 22:17.
