

SEEKS HIS OWN DESIRE

- Taking over your throne
- Doing what you want
- Serving the flesh
- Resisting God's will
- Casting off restraint

BREAKS AGAINST JUDGMENT

- The fool lacks judgement
- Resist doing the right thing
- Pursue the wrong path
- Seek desire regardless of consequences with ruthless pursuit
- No regard for truth / Ignores reality

WHAT IS ISOLATION

Whoever isolates himself seeks his own desire; he breaks out against all sound judgment. Proverbs 18:1

Isolation is the state we find ourselves where we live lives <u>separated</u> and <u>divided</u> from <u>others and God</u> because of sinful behavior, sinbased patterns, and pride.

Isolation causes <u>loneliness</u> and is characterized by a sense we alone, <u>separated</u> and <u>unable to connect with God or others</u>.

In isolation we are threatened and in competition with others and <u>we</u> <u>believe we can only sustain and improve our lives by our own efforts</u>.

We relentlessly strive to remove this tension by our own self righteousness. We believe the lie that I'm not that bad.

We weaponize isolation to punish others or protect ourselves (Ro 12:19)


We are tempted and give place to the enemy (Ep 4:27)




MOVING INTO COMMUNITY
