**Discussion Questions:**

1. Compare Philippians 1:1-2 and 4:21-23. What stands out to you about the way the Apostle Paul opens and closes his letter?
2. What is significant about the word "every" in Philippians 4:21? How does the Gospel apply to both our lives as individuals and as a community?
3. What is the Church? How was the church in Philippi connected to the church in Rome? How is Park Cities Presbyterian Church connected to other churches in Dallas and all over the world?
4. Why is it significant that Paul sent greetings to Philippi from the saints in Caesar's household? (See Philippians 4:22) What does this tell us about Paul's ministry while he was imprisoned in Rome?
5. How are Paul's last words in his letter to Philippi (Philippians 4:23) an echo of Philippians 1:27? What does it look like for us to be united in one spirit through the grace of Jesus Christ?
6. What passage in the book of Philippians has been most meaningful to you? Why?
