

*Profession of our Church's Faith in the Holy Spirit

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to Him. But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you. So then, brothers and sisters, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with Him in order that we may also be glorified with Him.

O Lord, my heart is not lifted up, my eyes are not raised too high; I do not occupy myself with things too great and too marvelous for me. But I have calmed and quieted my soul, like a child quieted at its mother's breast; like a child that is quieted is my soul. O Israel, O hope in the Lord from this time forth and forevermore.

In this Psalm, the Holy Spirit refers to a "lifted up heart" in a bad sense, that is, one whose heart is haughty. So this sung prayer (Psalm 131) affirms that a true disciple's heart is "not lifted up." Where do we see a perfect illustration of the trust, contentment and dependence of a heart not lifted up?...from a weaned child with its mother. Such Christ-like posture strengthens the church in all times and circumstances to "hope in the Lord from this time forth and forevermore."

to give thanks unto You, O Lord, Holy Father, Almighty,



John 16.4-15

Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send Him to you.
