People: <sup>19</sup>Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, and He delivered them from their distress.

Minister: <sup>20</sup>He sent out His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destruction.

People: <sup>21</sup>Let them thank the LORD for His steadfast love, for His wondrous works to the children of men!

Minister: <sup>22</sup>And let them offer sacrifices of thanksgiving, and tell of His deeds in songs of joy! <sup>23</sup>Some went down to the sea in ships, doing business on the great waters; <sup>24</sup>they saw the deeds of the LORD, His wondrous works in the deep. <sup>25</sup>For He commanded and raised the stormy wind, which lifted up the waves of the sea. <sup>26</sup>They mounted up to heaven; they went down to the depths; their courage melted away in their evil plight; <sup>27</sup>they reeled and staggered like drunken men and were at their wits' end.

People: <sup>28</sup>Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, and He delivered them from their distress.

Minister: <sup>29</sup>He made the storm be still, and the waves of the sea were hushed. <sup>30</sup>Then they were glad that the waters were quiet, and He brought them to their desired haven.

People: <sup>31</sup>Let them thank the LORD for His steadfast love, for His wondrous works to the children of men!

All: <sup>32</sup>Let them extol Him in the congregation of the people, and praise Him in the assembly of the elders.


