### Hearing and Learning God’s Word

**Scripture Reading:** *Galatians 5:22-23; John 14:25-31; John 16:32-33; 2 Peter 3:14*  
(*one person read the Scripture aloud*)

**Questions for Discussion** (*may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times*)

1. What is Peace and what is the *Peace of the Lord*? Is there a difference?
2. Why do we say, “The Peace of the Lord be with you . . . and also with you”?
3. How has God shown us He is a God of Peace?
4. Are you at Peace with God?
5. Are you at Peace with others?
6. What helps bring Peace (John 15)?
7. How are Peace and Patience connected?

#### **Questions for older children**

1. Why are so many Christians lacking Peace?
2. How have you known the Peace of the Lord?
3. From where did this Peace come?
4. Re-read John 14.25-31 and 16.32-33 and thank Him for His Peace.
