Haggai 1.1-9; 2.1-9

^{1.1} *In the second year of Darius the king, in the sixth month, on the first day of the month, the word of the LORD came by the hand of Haggai the prophet to Zerubabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest.* ² *"Thus says the LORD of hosts: These people say the time has not yet come to rebuild the house of the LORD."* ³ *Then the word of the LORD came by the hand of Haggai the prophet,* ⁴ *"Is it a time for you yourselves to dwell in your paneled houses, while this house lies in ruins?"* ⁵ *Now, therefore, thus says the LORD of hosts: Consider your ways.* ⁶ *You have sown much, and harvested little.*

Be strong, all you people of the land, declares the LORD. Work, for I am with you, declares the LORD of hosts, ⁵ according to the covenant that I made with you when you came out of Egypt. My Spirit remains in your midst. Fear not. ⁶ For thus says the LORD of hosts: Yet once more, in a little while, I will shake the heavens and the earth and the sea and the dry land. ⁷ And I will shake all nations, so that the treasures of all nations shall come in, and I will fill this house with glory, says the LORD of hosts. ⁸ The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, declares the LORD of hosts. ⁹ The latter glory of this house shall be greater than the former, says the LORD of hosts. And in this place I will give peace, declares the LORD of hosts.'"



Hearing and Learning God’s Word

Scripture Reading: Haggai 1.1-9; 2.1-9 *(one person read the Scripture aloud)*

Questions for Discussion *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. Have you ever heard the phrase, “first things first”? What does it mean? Why might it be important to listen to?
2. What is Haggai saying is wrong about Israel's choices? What's happened to them as a result of their choices?
3. Why is knowing what God thinks more important than what anyone else thinks?
4. How do we learn more about what God thinks?

Questions for older children

1. Did Haggai challenge Israel to rebuild the temple because they needed a new building, or was it for some other reason? What was that reason?
2. Jesus tells the Pharisees (John 2.18-22) that He is the temple. In what ways are the temple and Jesus alike? In what way is Jesus even greater than the temple?
3. How does Jesus fulfill (finish) what God promised through Haggai about bringing peace (2.9)?

Scripture Memory for June: *(memorize these verses of Scripture this month)*

Luke 24.25-27

And He said to them, “O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into His glory?” And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, He interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.
