

Hearing and Learning God's Word

Scripture Reading: I John 3.11-18 (one person read the Scripture aloud)

Questions for Discussion (may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)

- 1. Read 1 John 3.11. What is the message they have heard from the beginning?
- 2. Read (*or parents summarize*) the story of Cain and Abel in Genesis 4. What happened and why?
- 3. How does our love for the brothers reveal that we know Jesus?
- 4. How are we to love the brothers? Who is our example?
- 5. What does it mean to lay down your life?
- 6. What are we to do if we see or hear about a brother in need?
- 7. How can we as a family better love those in need?
- 8. Why should we love with action?

Questions for older children

- 1. How can we move from words to action?
- 2. What is revealed by love with action and what is revealed by love with no action?
- 3. What needs of the brothers (*other Christians*) are you aware of that you could help meet?
- 4. How is Christ calling you to love? Be specific.

Scripture Memory for May (memorize these verses of Scripture this month)

1 John 4.7-10

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. ⁸ Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. ⁹ In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent His only Son into the world, so that we might live through Him. ¹⁰ In this is love, not that we have loved God but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
