

Hearing and Learning God's Word

Scripture Reading: Galatians 5.22-23; 2 Timothy 2.8-13 (one person read the *Scripture aloud*)

Questions for Discussion (may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)

- 1. What does it mean to be faithful?
- 2. What does it mean to have faith? What do you have faith in?
- 3. How are you faithful to what you have faith in?
- 4. How is Jesus Christ faithful to you?

Questions for older children

- 1. Have you ever done something that was disloyal?
- 2. Is God ever disloyal to you? How do you know?
- 3. Does God's faithfulness depend on your faithfulness?
- 4. Have you ever doubted God? What did Jesus Christ do to overcome your doubt?
