

THE FIRST WORD OF CHRISTMAS "The Word's Three (Billion) Witnesses"

The witness of the one and only Son to the Father

Praise

Hearing and Learning God's Word

Scripture Reading: John 1.14-16 (one person read the Scripture aloud)

Questions for Discussion (may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)

- 1. What is a witness?
- 2. What did John the Apostle and John the Baptist witness?
- 3. What are we (all Christians) to witness to?
- 4. How do you witness to Jesus?

Questions for older children

- 1. In what ways is John's Gospel a "Book of Witness"? (Overall purpose; Signs)
- 2. Why is saying, "God changed into a man" not the right way to say what the Incarnation is?
- 3. Why is it important that Jesus was 100% God and 100% man?
- 4. How can you bear witness to the sufferings of Christ?

Scripture Memory for December: (memorize this verse of Scripture this month)

John 1.14
