



# Hearing and Learning God's Word

**Scripture Reading:** 1 Thessalonians 2.13 (one person read the Scripture aloud)

**Questions for Discussion** (may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)

- 1. What is Paul thankful for in verse 13?
- 2. What is the Word of God?
- 3. What is the difference between the Word of God and the word of men?
- 4. How is the Word of God at work in believers?
- 5. How have you seen God's Word at work in your life?

## Questions for older children

- 1. Why is Paul so thankful in this verse?
- 2. How should this teach us to show gratitude for God's Word?
- 3. How are you being transformed by God's Word?
- 4. How is God's Word helping you walk in a manner worthy of God?

### **Scripture Memory for April:** (memorize this verse of Scripture this month)

### Romans 6.9-11
