



- 6. If we disregard His instruction, who are we rejecting?

Questions for older children

- 1. Why do you think that Paul uses the phrase "more and more"?
- 2. How have you seen God's sanctifying work in your life lately?
- 3. How does the cross and resurrection of Jesus effect our sanctification?
