Maundy Thursday

Father, in Your plan of salvation, Your Son Jesus Christ accepted the cross and freed us from the power of the enemy. May we come to share the glory of His resurrection, for He lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever.

Maundy Thursday

The Thursday of Holy Week derives its name from the command Christ gave His followers to love one another (John 13.34) and "to wash" (Latin mundo), referring to Christ's washing the feet of the apostles.

As the remembrance of our Lord's institution of the Last Supper, Maundy Thursday is almost universally celebrated with the Lord's Table.

Tenebrae

from the Latin meaning "shadows," refers to the gathering of shadows during the Passion of our Lord. Scripture reveals the fulfillment of prophecy as the Lamb of God, the Son of Man, becomes the final sacrifice for our sins.

Minister: May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ,


through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the


