4.	Regarding His Word, what does the Lord command?
5.	What is the relationship between "knowing" the word of God and "living" the word of God?
6.	What is the current status of your love, affection, and desire to live the Word of God? Be honest as you reflect on this question.
7.	Where do you desire to be in your love and obedience to the Word of God?
8.	How does this section of Psalm 119 help us walk in His ways?
9.	Where is Christ in this Psalm and how critical is this to our understanding and obedience of His word?
