Last night in Africa. Everything is itching I think there are tsetse flies under my skin. I have lost 4 pounds at least, Kids are loving it, especially [REDACTED] He shot a wildebeast with his bow. [REDACTED] wants to hunt but we don't have a licence for her.

She has been taking tons of pictures, wants to buy a real good camera for her Bat Mitzvah money. I spent 5 hours in the local village yesterday by myself. It was soooooo primitive. The hospital had no electricity, no microscope and no running water. Plastic mattresses on the floor. Everyone here gets malaria, it's like us getting an earache. I went to the local school as well, the kitchen where they ate was a fire pit with a kettle a big pot and some cornporridge.

I am reading The Catcher in the Rye, I like it. We are leaving with a small plane tomorrow from a grass strip here to Mwanza where our plane is waiting. There was a plane crash on that route last week. Then we are off to Istanbul. [REDACTED] only wants to stay one night now. He doesn't like cities any more. I think he could live here!! I am going to like Istanbul I know, I loved Barcelona!

Thursday evening when we get to Sweden and we can unpack for a while, kids are looking forward to see their friends and Mimim and Morfar. What is the one hardest thing for you?? I would say constipation but maybe the coffee is strong. I doubt it. Would they accept coffee donations from an outsider?? What can we do for you??
