verbally provided.

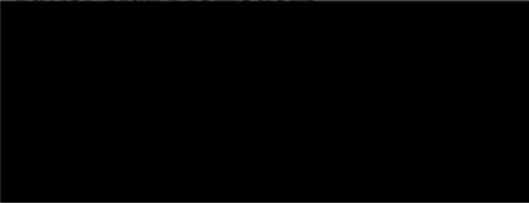
Quotes range from
