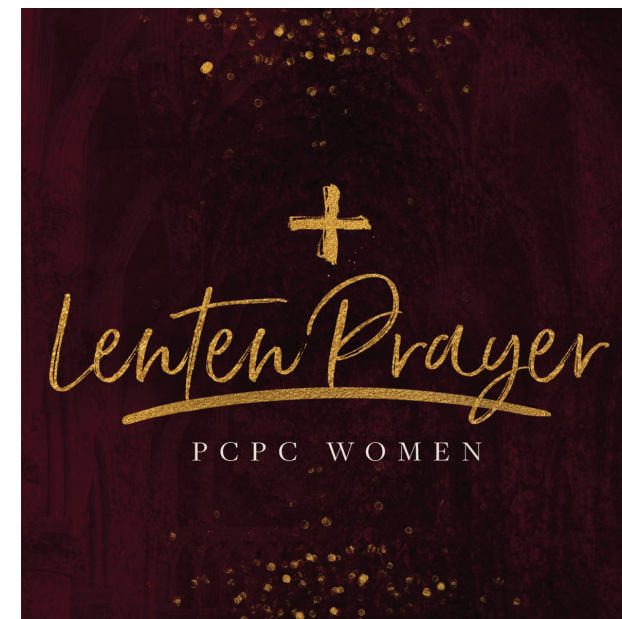
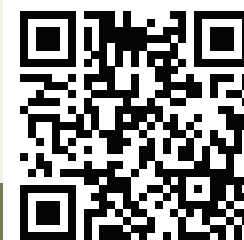

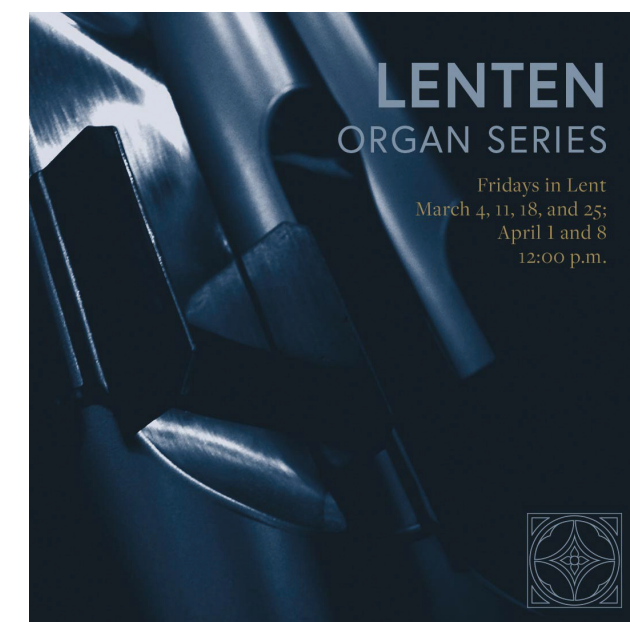


WOMEN'S LENTEN PRAYER
