The following questions help us dialog with the sermon, music, and liturgy in this morning's worship service. Together, these elements provide space for reflection and prayer during personal devotions, group studies, and family worship. 1. What does the Parting of the Red Sea teach us about the character of God? 3. What are you afraid of? How do our fears reveal the things that we worship? 4. What does it mean to fear the Lord? What does fear have to do with faith? 5. How did the Lord fight for the people of Israel at the Red Sea? How has the Lord fought for you? 6. Read Exodus 14.14. What did Moses tell the people of Israel to do while the Lord saved them at the Red Sea? Why is this a powerful encouragement for us? 7. How did the people of Israel "see the salvation of the LORD" at the Red Sea? How have you seen the salvation of the Lord?
