The following questions help us engage with the sermon, music, and liturgy in this morning's worship service, and may be useful during personal devotions, group studies, and family worship.

1. What is prayer? How would you explain prayer to someone who has never prayed before?
2. If God is sovereign over all things, then why do we pray?
Do our prayers matter?
3. Read Revelation 8.1. Why was there silence in heaven when the Lamb opened the seventh seal?
4. What does it look like to be silent before God? How can silence enable us to experience the presence of God?
5. Why did the angel offer incense with the prayers of the saints? What does this teach us about the power of prayer?
6. Who are the saints in Revelation 6:3? What does this tell you about your place in the Kingdom of God?
7. How does prayer extend the Kingdom of Jesus Christ? How might this change the way that you pray?
