Discussion Questions

The following questions help us engage with the sermon, music, and liturgy in this morning's worship service, and may be useful during personal devotions, group studies, and family worship.

1.	What is the Feast of the Epiphany? What does Epiphany have to do with Jesus and the Wise Men? What does Epiphany have to do with us?
2.	What does the word "transcendent" mean? What does the word "immanent" mean? How does the Christmas story teach us that Jesus is both?
3.	What was significant about Jesus being born in Bethlehem? How is the Kingdom of Jesus Christ different than the kingdoms of men?
4.	Why does the Kingdom of Jesus Christ threaten our own little worldly kingdoms?
5.	Why did Mary, Joseph, and Jesus flee to Egypt? How did this fulfill prophecy?
6.	Read Colossians 1.13. How has the Kingdom of Jesus delivered us from the kingdom of darkness?
