What is important to understand about Jesus showing the disciples His hands and His side? 5. How were the disciples to understand His "sending" them? Why is His relationship to the Father significant in this mission? 6. What do we learn about the Holy Spirit in this passage? 7. Where do you need the resurrection peace of Christ? 8. How does this passage encourage you to follow Christ?
