5.	What is the parenthetical warning given in this passage (16.15), and why is it so crucial for us to pay attention to?
6.	What is significant about the loud cry from the temple, "It is done"? (16.17)
7.	How are we to live as followers of the Lord Jesus in light of this vision given to John of this final battle?
