1. Why does Psalm 119.9 reference a “young man?” What do you think is the Psalmist's point?
2. What is the Psalmist seeking? How?
3. What role does the heart play in this Psalm?
4. How do we store or hide things in our heart?
5. What are the benefits of memorizing Scripture? Have you ever memorized Scripture? Are you currently memorizing Scripture? Why or why not?
6. How does this section of Psalm 119 reveal the Psalmist's zeal for the word?
7. How does this section of Psalm 119 reveal our need for the Lord?
8. What does it mean to “delight” in His Word?
