

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

The following questions help us engage with the sermon, music, and liturgy in this morning's worship service, and may be useful during personal devotions, group studies, and family worship.

1. Read Psalm 119.37 and Matthew 6.22-23. In the Bible, what do "eyes" represent?
2. What does the word "worthless" mean? What "worthless things" are we most captivated by?
3. What worthy things has God given us to see in His Word?
4. What does worship have to do with what we see?
5. What is the Hebrew letter "He" associated with? Why is this significant in this section of Psalm 119?
6. Read Psalm 119.40 and John 1.29. What does it mean to "behold" Jesus?
7. How does seeing Jesus turn our eyes from looking at worthless things?
